

## Janky Robots Tater Bots Workshop/Competition

The rules listed below are in addition to the official Hebocon rules posted on the Hebocon website ([hebocon.org](http://hebocon.org)). Rules specific to Janky Robots/Tater Bots should be followed in case of a conflict. Remember though: This is a friendly competition. Rules challenges and an intense focus on winning or destructive capabilities are antithetical to the spirit of Hebocon.

- The two motors provided to each participant are the only motors permitted.
- Either the housing or the axle of any motor used must be connected, directly or indirectly, to a potato or other vegetable (whole or cut).
- Participants may supply their own *non-motorized* and *non-powered* parts or materials. The use of liquids, powders, and gases is prohibited.
- The provided batteries, installed within the provided battery holders, are the only source of electrical power allowed.
- Microcontrollers or other electronic components for controlling the motors are not allowed.
- Untethered projectiles are not allowed.
- Any part deemed to be potentially unsafe must be removed or modified.
- The format used for the tournament will be determined by the organizer. The preferred format is double elimination.
